Resolution

Deposit Trial Balance (DPTB) calculations

DPTB no longer displays deposits with a zero balance when the Print Zero Balance flag is set to No.

However, if a reversed deposit was not transferred from another deposit, and both the reversed and reversing deposit fall within the start and cutoff dates, both deposits are included, even if that flag is set to No. This allows new deposits that occurred during the reporting date range to be displayed on the report.

The logic that reports the amounts of the Deposits, Allocations, and Refunds was also enhanced to clearly delineate the refunds and the allocations.

NOTE: When suppressing deposits with a zero balance, the totals of the Deposits and the Allocations and Refunds columns will not reflect the suppressed deposits. The Balance Forward and the Balance will continue to reflect the correct totals even when such deposits are suppressed.

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This update resolves change requests and makes enhancements to FA~Link that resolve some minor bugs and introduces new features.

#### Client Impact

Users have more control over how charges from the bookstore post to Colleague.

#### TECHNICAL IMPLEMENTATION

Institutions that had previously defined a voucher on BKVS to authorize Inclusive Access charges that were mixed with other bookstore charges in the same transaction no longer need to set up those vouchers and may instead flag the Inclusive Access AR code(s) on BKCF.

#### Resolution

Some transaction orders on student accounts prior to issuing them a refund voucher would result in FA~Link not accounting for that voucher and potentially over authorizing that student. This has been corrected, and refund vouchers will always be accounted for when determining a student's available funds at the bookstore.

Some institutions needed the ability to combine Inclusive Access charges with other bookstore charges; allowing Inclusive Access charges to post to the student's account regardless of available funds, and any other charges in the transaction to first authorize against the student's available funds. Institutions may now flag AR codes used for Inclusive Access charging on BKCF (detail on an AR code on BKCP) to bypass the authorization step.

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This release addresses defects that occur within payroll for Canadian Pension Plan (CPP) tax calculation.

In addition, a new row for Canada Employment Amount has been added to the Tax Credit Return (TCRT) form, which is a detail from the Tax Credit Return Summary (TCRS) form. These forms are used to collect data for TD1 reporting.

#### Problem/Issue

- o PD0020777 Colleague – Payroll YTD Enhanced CPP (CPP2) Taxable Amount is Short During the Pay Period in which an Employee Maxes out CPP2
- o PD0020914 Enhanced CPP (CPP2) may be incorrectly calculated because of the wrong Year to Date pensionable earnings in calculation
- o PD0020916 Enhanced CPP (CPP2) has incorrect Taxable Gross and Tax Amounts During the Pay Period in which an Employee Maxes Out the Base CPP
- o PD0021327 Colleague HR – AECP “Select Statement failed” for Canadian Unidata customers

#### Client Impact

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#### Resolution

PD0020777 The Year-to-Date Taxable Amount for Enhanced Canadian Pension Plan (CPP2) withholding could be a few pennies short of the maximum when the employee would hit the maximum.

Calculation of the CPP2 Year-to-Date Taxable Amount now hits the maximum to the penny.

PD0020914 Enhanced Canadian Pension Plan (CPP2) withholding was sometimes incorrect because the calculation was using all earnings, rather than pensionable earnings, for the calculation.

Calculation of CPP2 withholding now uses only pensionable earnings.

PD0020916 In the pay period when an employee would max out Base Canadian Pension Plan (CPP) withholding and cross into Enhanced Canadian Pension Plan (CPP2) withholding, Colleague was using the wrong pensionable earnings for the pay period.

Colleague now uses the correct pensionable earnings for the pay period when the CPP withholding threshold is reached and CPP2 withholding starts.

PD0021327 The Audit Enhanced CPP (AECP) report was failing for Unidata customers.

The AECP report now runs to completion for customers on Unidata.

May 15th, 2025 - The following software update has been released and available to clients to be installed with the Envision Release System:

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This update contains the fifth set of 2025 state tax table updates.

Idaho updated its withholding rate.

Utah had an official publication that was released and included an update.

Iowa required a change based on an earlier change of its official publication regarding the standard deduction.

States requiring Special Tax Subroutines for computing withholding required an update including Alabama, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Iowa (both methods), Massachusetts, Maryland, Oregon, South Carolina, Utah, and Wisconsin. Arkansas requires a Special Tax Subroutine, but did not need an update.

#### Problem/Issue

##### U.S. Tax Tables

For the 2025 Idaho tables, the withholding rate, minimum taxable amount, and Child Tax Credit Allowance were updated.

For the 2025 Utah tables, the withholding rate, base allowance amount and the standard deduction were updated.

For the 2025 Iowa tables, the Special Tax Subroutine needed to be updated so that the standard deduction would be based on filing status.

All states requiring a Special Tax Subroutine for processing withholding needed additional coding to ensure that the withholding amount did not calculate as a negative amount and did not calculate fractional amounts.

#### Client Impact

Clients can process 2025 state tax calculations correctly.

#### Implementation Instructions

Tax table updates that Ellucian delivers are not applied to your Colleague tax tables until the Import Tax Tables (IMTT) process is run. If you maintain the tax tables manually rather than through the IMTT process, install this software update but do not run the IMTT process. This will leave your tax tables unaffected.

NOTE: The Utah withholding tax table changes take effect starting June 1st. Do not run IMTT to update Utah tax codes until you are ready to run a payroll for June or later.

For the 2025 Idaho tax tables, the tax percent withholding rate, minimum taxable amount and withholding exemption amount were updated.

For the 2025 Utah tax tables, the withholding rate, base allowance amount, and standard deduction amounts were updated.

For the 2025 Iowa tax tables, the Special Tax Subroutines S.PR.TAX.SPC.IAST.M1 and S.PR.TAX.SPC.IAST.M2, were updated to use the standard deduction based on filing status.

All other state withholding tables requiring a Special Tax Subroutine were updated to prevent the calculation of a negative dollar amounts and fractional cent amounts, including these subroutines:

When Colleague processes incorrectly assign invalid float precision to numeric fields, Customers need a way to resolve these issues in the source files. The new HRPF utility is designed to allow the user to correct this issue in specific Colleague HR files as the need arises.

PD0023666 Recalculate Term Status Load (RTSL) process was locking all STUDENT.TERMS evaluated.

With the release of SU039601-1805\*21, the Recalculate Term Status Load (RTSL) process was locking any encountered STUDENT.TERMS records for the duration of the job. This prevented any STUDENT.TERMS updates while the job was running and for UniData clients, the large number of locks could reach the local limit and crash Unidata. This issue has been resolved.

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In Postgres, IS Subroutine functions were not including blank values in VL variables when association tables skipped row positions. Associated data was in sync between VL variables, but if a table skipped row position 2 (for example) the VL variables for that association didn't contain the corresponding nulls at position 2. This has been fixed in the IS Subroutine generator and while very little business logic need the null rows included, this update is redelivering all Postgres IS Subroutines that use multivalued data, to ensure the null rows are included in the event they make a difference.

59073.59 Needed a way to use a saved list on WLCL. The Waitlist Closure (WLCL) process has been updated to allow for a savedlist of COURSE.SECTIONS, Additional Selection Criteria, CSV report output, and Non-update mode. Note that WLCL will process all sections in the savedlist regardless of section end date. Please see online help for additional information.

CR-000154484 The Batch Case Reminder E-mail (BREM) process failed to send reminder emails to case workers assigned to multiple cases. This issue has been resolved.

PD0013638 The totals section columns on the Section Summary (SSUM) form no longer align with columns above. This issue has been resolved.

PD0019912 ACT Test import changes for 2025 layout. The layout for the ACT Test Score Import was changed with an effective date of April 1, 2025. The changes to the layout are marked in red in the ACT crosswalk and a new process, ACT Test Scores Import (ACT25), is delivered. No new data is imported with this process.

PE0004433 Include additional selection criteria or saved list option on WLCL. This issue has been resolved.

PE0005380 Release SU038779 delivered the ability to enter an alternate section number on the Additional Section Info (ASCI) form. It should be forced to all caps. This issue has been resolved. To use mixed case in this field use the equal sign before the value being entered.

PE0005918 The Course Name field on the Course Equate Codes (EQCD) form needed to display more characters. This issue has been resolved so that Course Name will now display 15 characters.

The Automated Room Assignment (ARAS) process needed to be updated to run in background mode. This issue has been resolved. Date fields have been updated to show 4 digit years, headers have been added to the assignment dates, and the ROOM.ASSIGNMENT file name has been added to the savedlist field. Note that because the ARAS process can generate error or warning message dialogs, the background processing can fail. ARAS will run in background mode if dialogs are NOT generated. This update partially resolves defect 6481.41.

The Recalculate Term Status/Load (RTSL) form was updated to an SPSP process, Non-update mode, CSV output, and the savedlist file name were added.

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Several areas need improvement, including calculation of charges, use of saved lists on GEWG, and other options to enhance the user experience.

### Problem/Issue

The following FVT/GE issues were reported or discovered:

PD20790: The National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) was rejecting the file upload due to leading zeros and extra spaces in the CSV export file from the FVT/Gainful Employment Report Export (GERX) Process.

PD20346: UniData clients after loading release SU040424-1805\*10, the new values for ST.GE.STU.INVALID.FLAG validation table did not update.

PD20345: Gainful Employment Workfile Generation (GEWG) process gives an error ST.OBJ/\_ACB064 and derivation for Program First Status seems incorrect.

PD20444: The GEWG process would not accurately report students that graduated or withdrew from a program in the Award Year but not within one of the Award Year Terms listed on the FVT/Gainful Employment Reporting Terms (GERT) form.

PD20300: The GEWG process would calculate the Books/Supplies amount from Budgets Components from the incorrect financial aid year for programs that start in Spring or Summer of the Award Year.

The FVT/Gainful Employment Workfile Maintenance (GEWM) form would allow users to create a new record with a program that the student was never enrolled in.

User requested a way to update the Cost of Attendance and Tuition/Fees fields on the FVT/Gainful Employment Program Information (GEPI) form using the FVT/Gainful Employment Batch Program Update (GEBP) process.

The FVT/Gainful Employment Program Enrollment Report (GPER) process created an export CSV with formatting issues due to commas being in the program name.

The FVT/GE Program Work File Generation (GEPG) and the FVT/Gainful Employment Report Export (GERX) processes would produce warning messages when certain fields were blank that were confusing.

Clients can now produce student and program work file records accurately.

The GEWM form now only allows users to create a new GE work file record with a program that the student is enrolled in.

The GEBP process now updates the Cost of Attendance and Tuition/Fees fields on GEPI.
