040213 Colleague Tax Tables, 1095C XML, And Canadian Year-End Update

This update contains the 2025 U.S Federal Tables, the second set of 2025 state tax tables, an update to the year marked on the 1095C XML export file, and Colleague UI changes to handle Canadian tax XML reporting changes, including adjustments to the set-up forms for the T4, T4A and T2202.

States for which official publications were released include MO, CT, OK, MA, CO, AZ, RI, IN, MT, NC, and NY.

Note that for Canadian clients only, this update works in conjunction with DMI Update SU039929-4.1.0*3 (SEVIS and Canadian Year End XML Changes), which is now also available for install.

Problem/Issue U.S. Tax Tables

The U.S. Federal tax tables were updated for 2025 using a draft version of IRS publication 15-t.

For the 2025 Hawaii tables, the tax bracket amounts changed, and a new "extra lump sum withholding allowance" of \$1,650 was added.

For the 2025 Indiana tables, the flat tax percentage changed to 3.00%.

For the 2025 Missouri tables, the tax bracket amounts changed including a reduction in the top bracket, and the standard deduction amounts increased.

For the 2025 Montana tables, the tax bracket amounts changed.

For the 2025 Nebraska tables, the tax bracket amounts changed, while the state withholding exemption increased.

For the 2025 New Mexico tables, the tax bracket amounts changed.

For the 2025 Rhode Island tables, the tax bracket amounts changed

For the 2025 North Carolina tables, the flat tax decreased.

Note: Other states made official announcements for 2025 but do not require Colleague updates since no tax tables, formulas, exemptions or deductions changed. These states include Arizona, Colorado, Connecticut, Oklahoma, New York and Massachusetts. Users from those states still need to run IMTT for 2025 to create the 2025 version of the 2024 tables, though, since no changes were made.

U.S. 1095C Reporting

The 1095C XML output that schools must submit did not have the correct year in the header section.

The XML of the Canadian tax form reports had the following issues. (Note that there were no changes to the tax forms themselves, just the XML.)

- The T619, which is the header section of the XML that gets sent to the CRA, had several fields removed for 2024 reporting, along with a new Transmitter Account Number and Transmitter Representative ID. This applies to all three Canadian tax forms T4, T4A and T2202. This resulted in a need for changes to the T4MM, TAMM, and T2AD forms.
- The T4 contains several new XML fields to report.
- The T4 The T4 cd> tag is not properly populated with a 0 when there is no value to report.

Client Impact

Clients can process 2025 state tax calculations correctly. Also, clients can now more easily import their custom subroutines.

Implementation Instructions

Tax table updates Ellucian delivers are not applied to your Colleague tax tables until the Import Tax Tables (IMTT) process is run. If you maintain the tax tables manually rather than through the IMTT process, install this software update but do not run the IMTT process. This will leave your tax tables unaffected.

For Canadian tax XML processing, you must populate the new Transmitter Account Number Source and Transmitter Account Number fields, or the new Transmitter Rep ID field, on the T4MM, TAMM, and T2AD forms in order to create a properly formatted and populated XML document to send to the CRA. You must also add whichever of the new boxes and codes on TFBX that your school needs to report (90, 91, 92, 94, and 95).

Resolution U.S. Tax Tables

The 2025 U.S. Federal Income Tax withholding was updated with new tax bracket amounts.

For the 2025 Hawaii tax tables, the tax bracket amounts were updated. There was also a new "extra lump sum withholding allowance" that was added for all filing statuses and operates similarly to a standard deduction, so a \$1,650 Standard Deduction was added for all filing statuses, even though it is called a "withholding allowance".

For the 2025 Missouri tax tables, the tax bracket amounts were updated, as well as the Standard Deduction.

For the 2025 Nebraska tax tables, the tax bracket amounts were updated, and the withholding exemption amount was increased.

For the 2025 Indiana, Montana, New Mexico, North Carolina, and Rhode Island tax tables, the tax bracket amounts were updated.

U.S. 1095C Reporting

The 1095C XML record that gets created by the CXML process now contains the year "2024" in the header section.

Canadian Tax XML Reporting

Several changes were made in Colleague to accommodate the CRA changes to the tax form XML for the T4, T4A, and T2202.

The T4IC, TAIC, and T2AD forms have three new fields: Transmitter Account Number Source, Transmitter Account Number, and Transmitter Representative ID. If you log in via MyBA or WAC, you must report a Transmitter Account Number. To do this, you must first populate the Source field with whichever value is the source of your Transmitter Account Number – your BN9 (Business Number 9), BN15 (Business Number 15), Trust number, or Non-Residential (NR4) number. Then, in the Transmitter Account Number field, enter whatever value you want to report, up to 15 characters. The tag reported in the XML will report your Transmitter Account Number and the source of that value that you set up on the form listed above.

If you log in via RAC, you must report a Transmitter Rep ID. To report this value, enter the appropriate value in the Transmitter Rep ID field. If you choose, you can submit both a Transmitter Account Number and a Transmitter Rep ID, but you must submit at least one of the two.

In addition, the T4 export process (T4MM), which creates the T4 XML, was updated to handle five new tags to report on the T4 XML record. These tags are populated by creating boxes on the TFBX form with the codes associated to each tag. The new tags (and associated codes) are:

Finally, the T4 <prov_pip_xmpt_cd> tag now properly populates with 0 when it cannot populate with 1.

Note: This update works in conjunction with DMI Update SU039929-4.1.0*3 (SEVIS and Canadian Year End XML Changes), which is now also available for install.

040473 Colleague State Tax Tables, Part 3

This software update includes the third set of 2025 state tax tables.

States for which official publications were released include LA, MN, MS, ND, OR, and VT.

Problem/Issue U.S. Tax Tables

For the 2025 Louisiana tables, the tax withholding was dramatically simplified and is now a flat tax of 3.09% with an optional standard deduction.

For the 2025 Minnesota tables, the tax bracket amounts changed, and the withholding exemptions increased.

For the 2025 Mississippi tables, the flat tax percentage was reduced.

For the 2025 North Dakota tables, the tax bracket amounts changed and the value of an allowance changed.

For the 2025 Oregon tables, the tax bracket amounts changed, while the state allowance and standard deduction amounts changed.

For the 2025 Vermont tables, the tax bracket amounts changed, and the withholding exemptions increased.

Note: Other states made official announcements for 2025 but do not require Colleague updates since no tax tables, formulas, exemptions or deductions changed. This includes Georgia. Users from Georgia still need to run IMTT for 2025 to create the 2025 version of the 2024 tables, though, since no changes were made.

Client Impact

Clients can process 2025 state tax calculations correctly.

Resolution U.S. Tax Tables

For the 2025 Louisiana tax tables, the withholding methods were changed to use a flat tax withholding of 3.09% and a simplified standard deduction was added.

For the 2025 Mississippi tax tables, the flat tax percent was updated.

For the 2025 Oregon tables, the tax bracket amounts were updated, the state allowance amount was increased, and the standard deduction amounts were updated.

For the 2025 Minnesota, North Dakota, and Vermont tax tables, the tax bracket amounts were updated, and the withholding exemption amount was increased.

040567 Colleague 2025 Tax Tables, Part 4

This update contains the fourth set of 2025 state tax tables.

States for which official publications were released include Arkansas, Illinois, Maryland, Michigan, and West Virginia.

Additional updates were made to Oklahoma and Oregon.

Pre-install Instructions

Tax table updates that Ellucian delivers are not applied to your Colleague tax tables until the Import Tax Tables (IMTT) process is run. If you maintain the tax tables manually rather than through the IMTT process, install this software update but do not run the IMTT process. This will leave your tax tables unaffected.

For institutions performing withholding for Oklahoma, additional steps are needed. Choose one of the following actions:

Before running the IMTT process to update the tax withholding values, remove the Special Tax Subroutine entry on EETT, which is most likely S.PR.TAX.SPC.OKST. IMTT will re-enter a subroutine of S.PR.TAX.SPC.RND. Or, following the running of IMTT, manually change the Special Tax Subroutine on EETT to S.PR.TAX.SPC.RND.

Problem/Issue U.S. Tax Tables

For the 2025 Arkansas tables, the tax bracket amounts and the standard deduction were updated.

For the 2025 Illinois and Michigan tables, the withholding exemption amounts increased.

For the 2025 Maryland tables, the standard deduction range was updated.

For the 2025 West Virginia tables, the tax bracket amounts changed.

For the 2025 Oklahoma tables, the Special Tax Subroutine used needed to be updated to use a rounding subroutine instead of a special one just for Oklahoma.

For the 2025 Oregon tables, the Special Tax Subroutine required both versions of the tax brackets to be entered into Colleague, including the tables for incomes below \$50,000 and the tables for incomes above \$50,000.

Client Impact

Clients can process 2025 state tax calculations correctly.

Resolution

U.S. Tax Tables

For the 2025 Arkansas tax tables, the standard deduction was updated. Colleague currently does not update the tax bracket amounts for Arkansas due to the large number of brackets, so clients will continue to need to manually update the Taxable Amounts, Tax Amounts, and Tax Percents.

For the 2025 Illinois and Michigan tax tables, the withholding exemption amounts were increased.

For the 2025 Maryland tables, the standard deduction amounts were updated.

For the 2025 West Virginia tax tables, the tax bracket amounts were updated.

For the 2025 Oklahoma tables, it was determined that the Special Tax Subroutine needed to be changed to S.PR.TAX.SPC.RND, which is a rounding subroutine, instead of S.PR.TAX.SPC.OKST. This was due to client feedback that Colleague was correctly calculating the withholding amounts without the special Oklahoma subroutine, except for rounding. The Import Tax Tables (IMTT) process does not currently allow the removal or replacement of the Special Tax Subroutine on the Employee Tax Table (EETT) form that has already been listed for a tax code, so users that run IMTT will need to either manually change the subroutine to S.PR.TAX.SPC.RND, or erase the current entry of S.PR.TAX.SPC.OKST, before running IMTT.

For the 2025 Oregon tables, two additional brackets were added to the tax tables. These represent the withholding methods used for incomes above \$50,000 and are used by the custom subroutine S.PR.TAX.SPC.ORST.

February 6th, 2024 - The following software update has been released and available to clients to be installed with the Envision Release System:

This release includes critical updates to submission files for the Canada T4, T4A, and T2202.

Problem/Issue

The CRA requires the "layout-topologie.xsd" file in the <Submission> tag to be replaced with "T619_<Form_Type>.xsd". However, the current export still references "layout-topologie.xsd" instead of the correct "T619_<Form_Type>.xsd" for T4, T4A, and T2202, leading to file rejections.

PD0020668: T4 XML does not conform to CRA requirements for filing 2024 tax year. The "layout-topologie.xsd" file must be replaced with "T619_T4.xsd".

PD0020672: T4A XML does not conform to CRA requirements for filing 2024 tax year. The "layout-topologie.xsd" file must be replaced with "T619_T4A.xsd".

PD0020671: T2202 XML does not conform to CRA requirements for filing 2024 tax year. The "layout-topologie.xsd" file must be replaced with "T619_T2202.xsd".

Client Impact

Canadian customers can now generate tax files that meet CRA requirements, ensuring successful submission and processing.

Resolution

The T4MM, TAMM, and T2XG processes now generate XML files that reference T619_T4.xsd, T619_T4A.xsd, and T619_T2202.xsd in their <Submission> tags. This ensures that the CRA accepts the files.

040688 Colleague Canadian 2024 CPP Report for Pensionable Earnings

This release delivers the Audit Enhanced CPP (AECP) report that identifies employees whose Enhanced (CPP2) Contributions and Taxable Gross amounts were not as expected for tax year 2024.

The underlying issues that cause the incorrect CPP Pensionable Earnings are listed below. These defects will be correct on Release 040750.

- PD0020914 Enhanced CPP (CPP2) may be incorrectly calculated because of the wrong Year-To-Date pensionable earnings in calculation
- PD0020916 Enhanced CPP (CPP2) has incorrect Taxable Gross and Tax Amounts During the Pay Period in which an Employee Maxes Out the Base CPP



- The <StudentRemarks> tag is required to be added for the off-campus employment add and edit transactions, specifically in the SEVIS-ADD-OFF-CAMPUS-OUT.xsl and SEVIS-EDIT-OFF-CAMPUS-OUT.xsl stylesheets, and should be a required field.
- The <Remarks> tag, which already existed, is now mandatory for drop below full course add or edit transactions. Changes are made in SEVIS-ADD-DROP-BELOW-FC-OUT.xsl and SEVIS-EDIT-DROP-BELOW-FC-OUT.xsl stylesheets.

If SSN starts with '000', '666', between '900-999' or has '00' in the middle two numbers or '0000' in the last four digits, SSN will not be used to derive SB00. Instead, the student's Colleague ID number (PERSON.ID) is obtained to derive the Student Identifier (SB00).

If the Colleague ID is longer than eight digits in length, it is truncated to eight digits.

A "D" (designated) is added to the front of the Colleague ID number for a total of nine characters, and this number is reported to the state as the student's identifier.

This software update provides the ability to import 2025/2026 TASFAs, along with some minor adjustments to FAD001 fields.

Problem/Issue

The 2025/2026 TASFA applications are soon going to be delivered to schools for importing.

The TTFL (TASFA Forced Link) process needed to be updated for both 2024/2025 and 2025/2026 processing.

The 9-Month COA field on the FAD001 report cannot be greater than 999,999, but a higher value can be calculated, causing issues when users run the BAWF process.

The FADE process yielded a warning when a student's income is over \$400,000, which is not a relevant message, since the income can be reported up to 999,999.

Client Impact

Clients can now import 2025/2026 TASFAs, as well as have smoother FAD001 processing.

Custom Impact

If any custom changes have been made to any of the following processes, they will need to be reapplied after loading this software update:

The FADE process was updated to no longer issue a warning about a student's income exceeding \$400,000.
